PELLA & THE BLOOMS

May 3 – 8, 2018

Nothing says **SPRINGTIME** like tulips in Pella, IA ... a charming village that celebrates its Netherlands heritage with a tulip festival in May! Founded in 1847 by 800 Norwegian immigrants, the village is transformed into a kaleidoscope of colors! Pella is the centerpiece of our trip ... but there is so much more along the way including Will Rogers Memorial Museum, the Amana Colonies, Walter Cronkite Memorial, the Hallmark Visitors Center, and the Walmart Museum!!

Thursday ... May 3rd:

We begin our journey as we travel north through the **"SOONER STATE", OKLAHOMA**, and into the **"SHOW ME STATE", MISSOURI**.
