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NATCHEZ PILGRIMAGE

April 10 - 12, 2018

NATCHES, MS!! Where the river is wide and the history runs deep!! The oldest settlement on the Mississippi River, Natchez has more antebellum houses than any other place in the United States and many of these historic homes are open for tours during the **SPRING PILGRIMAGE**. The friendly local people welcome visitors to their historic city with warm Southern charm. Join us as we tour some of the local favorites such as **LONGWOOD (1860-1861)**, **SHIELDS TOWN HOUSE (1860)**, **LINDEN (1800)**, **STANTON HALL (1858)**, **ROTHLAND (1817)**, and so much more!

Day 1:

We travel today to Natchez, MS arriving just in time for lunch On Your Own in the Natchez Downtown Area. Our afternoon will be spent on a Motor-Coach Guided Tour of Natchez as we get familiar with our surroundings and learn the history surrounding **NATCHEZ, MISSISSIPPI**.

Day 2:

Today's activities include touring several homes shown below as well as lunch at the **CARRIAGE HOUSE** and dinner at **THE PILOT HOUSE**.

LONGWOOD, also known as Nutt's Folly, is an historic antebellum octagonal mansion located at 140 Lower Woodville Road in Natchez.



ROUTHLAND was built for John Routh. Surrounded by acres of lawn, native plants and seasonal flowers, this large plantation-style house is most commanding. The spacious gallery extends a warm welcome to this historic home.



SHIELDS TOWN HOUSE is architecturally significant as an example of a well-designed and -executed late-Greek Revival city residence. It is historically significant to Natchez as the residence of a locally prominent upper-middle-class family of the antebellum period and as one of the last major antebellum residences constructed within the corporate limits of the city.



STANTON HALL, also known as Belfast, is an Antebellum Classical Revival mansion in Natchez. Built in the 1850s, it is one of the most opulent antebellum mansions to survive in the southeastern United States. It is now operated as a historic house museum by the Pilgrimage Garden Club.



Day 3:

Today is our last day reliving the Historic Rich History of **NATCHEZ, MISSISSIPPI**. Prior to departing, we have one more home to tour. **LINDEN**, originally owned by Alexander Moore and passed down to his son, James Moore, the central two-story, 4-room section of the mansion was constructed in 1785, and known as "Oaklands". It passed ownership several times and in 1849, Jane E. Conner purchased Linden after her husband died, for herself and her 9 children. She planted 7 Cedars of Lebanon in front of Linden, which still stand today. The current owner is the 6th generation of the Conner family.



We now make our way back to Tyler as we relive some of the wonderful experiences of the past three days with new friends that will want to explore many new trips created by AMERICAN TOURS
