TRAINS OF THE COLORADO ROCKIES!

August 12 - 18, 2019

If you love locomotives, riding on trains, **FANTASTIC SCENRY**, and cooler weather in August, then this trip is for you. This trip will include 3 of the most scenic, historic trains in Colorado. The **CUMBRES & TOLTEC**, built in 1880 begins in Antonito, CO. and ends in Chama, NM. It is pulled by a 1925 Steam Engine. Next, we will ride the Durango & Silverton **NARROW GAUGE** from Durango, CO. to Silverton, CO. In operation since 1882, the train is pulled through the San Juan Mountains by a 100% Coal-Fired, Steam Engine. The third adventure will be through the Royal Gorge on the **ROYAL GORGE RAILWAY**, considered by some to be one of the most spectacular scenic railroads in the world. Towards the end of this tour, we get back to God's Country, **TEXAS!!** We will be reminded why we love our state so much as we venture into the **PALO DURO CANYON** for a scrumptious barbeque dinner and the famous musical "TEXAS"!

Day 1:

This morning, we set off across the northern plains of Texas to **WICHITA FALLS** for a brief stop for lunch. Along with our stretch break, we should arrive in **AMARILLO** around 5:00 PM in time to freshen up a bit before dinner. Dinner tonight will be **FREE** at the hotel or *On Your Own* at one of several restaurants within walking distance.

Day 2:

We will travel more of our great Texas Panhandle, into **NEW MEXICO** and **COLORADO**, with a stop in Trinidad for lunch. Our journey will continue to **THE GREAT SAND DUNES NATIONAL PARK**. These dunes are over 12,000 years old and were formed by the Rio Grande River! You will be amazed at the color and shapes of the dunes.

Day 3:

This morning, we will board the **CUMBRES & TOLTEC SCENIC RAILWAY**. The excitement begins the moment the train leaves the station in Antonito, Colorado. Leaving the vast, open San Luis Valley, the imposing peaks of the **ROCKY MOUNTAINS** seem to stretch forever. The train quickly covers the flat ground and reaches a series of hills. It crosses Ferguson's Trestle, named for a man who was hung there, then climbs to a lava mesa, a remnant of the mountains' volcanic past. From here, the route winds around wide curves, going up into the mountains. White-barked, slender aspen trees, which turn yellow-gold in fall, form a light, whispery forest. Sublette, New Mexico, an abandoned railroad town, still provides water for the steam locomotives. Wildlife abounds throughout the area, with bears, elk, and deer roaming the forests and hawks and eagles patrolling the sky.

Day 4:

This morning, we will board the **SILVERTON & DURAGO NARROW GAUGE RAILROAD**. Ride this scenic, historic train between the towns of Durango and Silverton along the Animas River through wilderness, un-accessible by any road! You will enjoy scenic views of the Colorado Rockies, valleys, and old mining towns! After lunch, we will board our motor-coach headed for **SALIDA**.

Day 5:

Our next locomotive adventure is the **ROYAL GORGE RAILWAY**. This train ride will be different than the others as we will ride a cog rail to the bottom of Royal Gorge! You will be up close and personal with the Arkansas River, which carved Royal Gorge! You will also have time to enjoy the nice gift shops and walk across the **ROYAL GORGE EXPANSION BRIDGE**, if you so choose. If you have a wild side, you will have an opportunity to **ZIP LINE** across this spectacular gorge.

We will say goodbye to the **COLORADO ROCKIES** as we travel back to Amarillo for the night. We've seen a lot, but it's time to get back into God's Country, **TEXAS**! We'll enjoy more of the beauty of **NEW MEXICO**, arriving in **AMARILLO** in time to freshen up a bit before joining the staff at **PALO DURO CANYON** for a scrumptious barbeque dinner and the famous musical "**TEXAS**"! You'll see just how it all got started with Palo Duro Canyon as a backdrop!
